After 26 years in the motor industry specialising in vehicle safety and environmental legislation, he became a freelance writer and consultant in 2006.

His interest in philately began at the age of 6 and 20 years of age he spent in Singapore studying under his father in the stamps of that region, encouraged by his father's membership of Singapore Stamp Club.


He joined the Malaya Study Group in 1988 and has, since 1996, provided the New Issues Column for 'The Malayan Philatelist', of which he became Editor in 2010. He started work on the present volume in 1995.

He is also a member of Singapore Stamp Club and the Sarnacki Specimens Society, and a Fellow of the Royal Philatelic Society London. He holds various posts in local and regional philatelic societies.

Wide interests include railways, which he has combined with philately in the study of the carriage of mail by underground railway, which he described in "Mail Under London", published in 2000. He has also written extensively for various society publications and stamp magazines.

Volume 3 - Malaysia Post 2 - 1995 to 2009 and Revenue Stamps.  
Malaysia came into existence in 1959 incorporating the Federation of Malaya, North Borneo (Sabah), Sarawak and, until 1963, Singapore. This book explores the stamps and postal stationery issued from 1955 to 2009, including, where known, all varieties. This period was one of incredible complexity, with watermark, paper and perforation varieties to keep even the most avid collector fully occupied for a very long time. The latest revenue stamps of Malaysia are also described in full. Finally, for those seeking new fields for research, this volume lists known information on a number of "back-of-the-book" subjects. The four colour volume contains 400 pages and includes extensive thematic listings.

Volume 1, which received a Large Universal award at the 2011 World Philatelic Exhibitions, covered the federated period from 1948 to 1963, while Volume 2 covered Malaysia from 1963 to 1995 plus postage due labels. Supplementary information for subsequent years will usually be provided through the columns of 'The Malayan Philatelist', the journal of The Malaya Study Group.
