CHAPTER SEVENTY-SIX

YEAR PACKS & ALBUMS

Year packs, usually known as "Annual Albums", containing samples of all special stamps issued during the calendar year in question, were first issued in 1989, incorporating the previous year's issues. Whilst miniature sheets were usually included, imperforate versions, booklet stamps and other special items were omitted, unless otherwise stated.

In later years, where sheets of stamps contained mixed perforations, various watermarks or were available in several forms, the albums, being aimed at the general public, not collectors, ignored such variations. It was inevitable that albums for the same year could contain different combinations of such varieties, particularly where they occurred in the same sheet. It is not unknown for albums to contain stamp variations not found in the normal course of events when, by chance, the sheet(s) containing the variety had been set aside for pack production.

NOTE: The descriptions below are of the content of albums seen by the author and readers may find different content in any album they may obtain. Interpretation of the abbreviations used can be found by referring to the issues concerned,
